

From Neanderthal to Sapiens



Caveman Classification

Before Northpointe:

- Classification consisted of
 - Adult or Juvenile
 - Male or Female
 - Misdemeanor or Felon
- No classification decisions based on violent vs nonviolent behavior or crime
 - Felony check forgers housed with murders
- Protective Custody was freely and almost automatically approved

Modern Classification

- Pre-arraignment initial classification separation based on <u>age, gender and seriousness of crime</u>, but:
 - Violent and non-violent felons are separated
 - Required under Ohio minimum jail standards
 - Protective Custody is now restricted to those with a true need
 - Articulable and verifiable
 - Pre-arraignment felons are now housed separate from post-arraignment



The Great Shuffle

- To comply with Ohio minimum jail standards & objective classification philosophy:
 - Create a booking "pre-classification" to guide housing decisions for pre-arraignment inmates
 - Post-arraignment inmates had to be classified
 - ADP of 1800-2200
 - All housing maps needed to be reworked to:
 - Create space for 3 custody levels for pre/post-arraignment housing and protective custody
 - Creating housing for previously unidentified high risk and special conditions populations
 - More efficient use of single cells



JMegaJail

New Franklin County
Correction Center is
specifically designed for:

Direct supervision and inmate behavior management

Housing for high risk and special condition inmates

Separation based on the Northpointe custody and classification levels

Housing where care, custody, and control is appropriate for the needs of the inmate and the risk to facility and staff



 - Change of hardware
 - Change in operating system

Local Host

Local control

Better API integration

No need for CJIS certification

No reoccurring subscription costs

Upfront costs (servers & infrastructure)

Server has to be customized

Server maintenance (HW/SW)

Direct connection from vendor to server

Responsible for any downtime

Additional FTE duties



Cloud Host

No equipment or up-front costs

Vendor configured

Vendor managed

Vendor holds contract w/ cloud service

Hosting cost is spread across the contract

No additional FTE duties

No local control

Outside the county data center 'sandbox'

CJIS required

APIs difficult or impossible

Hosting cost at the end of the contract could spike



The Decision...



API

- Bi-directional information flow is challenging
- Credentialing between sandbox and cloud

CJIS

Requiring CJIS limited cloud vendor options

Downtime

- No control over downtime
- No ability to estimate return time to normal
- Information from cloud vendor can be "vague"
